


The Chosen Ones



themselves.









The World is Your Classroom



These partnerships with Siena University and St. Bonaventure University make a college degree not only **accessible**, but very **affordable** for Roger Bacon students.

Siena University

- Automatic admission for 3.0 GPA or higher
- **Guaranteed \$80,000, 4 year scholarship** ON TOP of any merit or need based aid awarded by school (average award given is approx. \$30,000 \$39,000
- For any student that does not earn degree in 4 years, Siena will cover 100% of tuition until degree earned

St. Bonaventure University

- Roger Bacon students receive a guaranteed \$20,000, 4 year scholarship
- Avg. award package = \$120,000 / \$30,000 per year, with avg. cost to attend \$16,000 before RB award applied


